

Response to Questions - #1

1. Most Cities do not require Stamped Engineered Drawings for the shelters at bid because the cost for engineering is about \$1500.00...the reason for this is if the bus shelter manufacture submitting the bid and does not win then manufacture loses that money. This is always done after award for the manufacture to send the drawings out for Engineering of the Structural Windloads and Footing Design.

We are not asking for the drawings until after award and prior to construction.

Section C-3. states:

Three (3) complete sets of each bus shelter model design drawings and engineering specifications, signed by a State of California registered Structural Engineer, shall be provided to the City of Madera Engineering Department, Attention: Jose E. Aguilar, 205 W. 4th Street, Madera, CA 93637, at least twenty (20) days prior to construction of any modular components.

2. Approved Equals when is the deadline to submit approved equal drawings.

Deadline for submittals is 12/20/16.
