



## 2018 Annual Residential Curbside Clean-up Program

Collection Areas for Monday, March 19, 2018 through Friday, April 27, 2018

This is your official notice of the 2018 Annual Residential Curbside Clean-up Program for your area

The Annual Residential Curbside Clean-up Program is designed to assist City of Madera Single-family homeowners and residents (**not county residents**) in the removal of excess trash, rubbish, and other bulky goods such as stoves, refrigerators, water heaters, furniture, mattresses, and children's play sets not collected during normal weekly service.

**DO NOT PUT OUT DEBRIS MORE THAN 7 DAYS BEFORE YOUR PICK-UP DATE!**

Trash placed out earlier than 7 days before the scheduled pick-up creates a hazard and **will be referred to Code Enforcement for possible citation and/or legal action.**

**Illegal Dumping, how can you help?** Gather the following information: describe the vehicle, type, color, license plate number, date, time of the dump, and a description of the individuals(s). **Report to Code Enforcement: 661-5114.**

### **Do's (Accepted)**

- > Place the clean-up discards in the same location as your regular collection in the street 6" from curb to allow drainage.
- > Do not block sewer vents, water inlets, mail boxes, fire hydrants or speed bumps.
- > There will be no alley collections.
- > **Set out all items to be collected by 6:00 am on your scheduled day of service. Any materials added after 6:00AM on your day of collection will not be picked up.**
- > Allow all day for the completion of your area. Tree pruning, lumber, and metal/plastic pipe must be cut into four foot pieces.
- > Secure or remove refrigerator and/or large appliance doors to prevent accidents.
- > Disassemble swing sets and cut into four foot sections.
- > Metal car parts must be drained of all fluids. Roll and tie carpeting and padding.
- > Separate green waste from other materials.
- > Place unbroken T.V.'s and computer monitors at the curb.
- > Avoid parking your car on the street on the day of collection for your area.
- > Put used oil and used oil filters near your carts on your normal day of collection.
- > Take up to 5 gallons of paint with label on can to Sherwin-Williams Paint Store located at 1809 Howard Road.
- > Move basketball courts to sidewalk during curbside collection.

### **Don'ts (Not Accepted)**

- > No hazardous materials such as fluorescent tubes, batteries, pesticides or chemicals including pool acid, aerosols, weed killers, and antifreeze.
- > No propane tanks or compressed cylinders
- > No fluids, grease, or oils will be collected.
- > No explosive materials including ammunition. No used motor oil, brake, and transmission fluids.
- > No 50 gallon drums.
- > No paint.
- > No treated wood utility poles or railroad ties.
- > No raw garbage.
- > No materials resulting from private contract work and major remodeling work done by contractor or owner including: roofing projects, remodeling projects or major landscaping projects.
- > No tree balls over 12 inches.
- > No Palm Tree rounds.
- > No tile, cement or bricks will be collected. Takes these items to Lee's Concrete located at 200 Pine St. for disposal.
- > No grass clippings, leaves, dirt or yard work materials will be collected. Place these materials in your green carts for normal collection and disposal.
