

**NOTICE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PUBLIC  
HEARINGS FOR PREPARATION OF THE CITY OF  
MADERA'S 2018/2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The City is interested in funding efforts designed to improve outcomes for low- to moderate-income persons, households and seniors through programs and projects that address seniors, youth, homelessness and public facility/infrastructure improvements. The deadline to apply is 5:00 p.m., April 13, 2018. The amount available is \$107,454.

The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has programs to provide decent housing, economic opportunities and meeting public service needs. HUD requires all jurisdictions receiving grants from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program prepare an Annual Action Plan.

The Action Plan is a one-year plan to deal with the most pressing needs of the community during that year and includes a description of the programs and projects to be implemented. For fiscal year 2018/2019, the City of Madera expects to program a CDBG entitlement grant from HUD in the approximate amount of \$716,363, as well as \$45,538 from the Small Business Revolving Loan Program. **The City is uncertain about the final amount of CDBG funds it will receive in 2018/2019; however, the City will make needed adjustments after final Federal budget allocation. In addition, recipients of the City's CDBG funds shall be required to spend their allocation on or before the 2018/2019 Program Year ends (June 30, 2019.)**
